The incumbent performs a variety of routine work within established policies and procedures and receives detailed instructions on new projects and assignments.

#### **Responsibilities/Duties**

- Cleaning and disinfecting of clinic space.
- Cleaning of NVE housing, as needed.
- Participate in infection control training.
- Cleaning includes, but is not limited to:
  - Windows, floors, restrooms, and other areas of clinic to ensure patient and employee safety.
  - o Disposal of wastes in wastebaskets as well as clean the wastebaskets.
  - Appropriate disposal of medical waste products like syringes, hand gloves, face mask, sachets of tablets, etc.
  - O Dusting of furniture, fixtures, and equipment.
  - o Replenishing soap and paper supplies.
  - o Disinfecting areas where there may have been blood or bodily fluid contact.
  - Using various types of cleaning equipment, like vacuum cleaners, washing machines, etc.
  - Documenting the procedure involved in the disposal of clinic waste products and ensure that the right procedure in line with the standard practice of the clinic, is followed.
