


happening in February!**

Every household that participates in the survey will be eligible for several raffle drawings. Don't miss your chance to win!



This February, your household may be randomly selected to participate in a survey on your harvest and use of wild foods including fish, game, and plant resources. This survey will fill a **10-year data gap** by documenting Cordovans' connections to wild foods, concerns about access to wild resources, and local knowledge on harvest practices. Results help inform regulatory processes: **make sure your voice is heard!**

Surveys are voluntary and confidential.
