



SOCIAL SERVICE RESERVE FUND (SSRF)

Providing temporary assistance to enrolled Active Tribal Members experiencing financial hardship or emergency situations.

SSRF CAN BE USED FOR:



GENERAL ASSISTANCE

- Emergency Utility Assistance
- Emergency Heating Equipment
- Emergency Home Repair



EXTENDED ASSISTANCE FOR ELDERS AND VULNERABLE TRIBAL MEMBERS

Extended assistance based on demonstrated need.



SUPPLEMENTAL BURIAL ASSISTANCE

- Up to \$1,000 toward burial-related expenses.



EMERGENCY HOUSING ASSISTANCE (UP TO 5 DAYS)

- Up to 5 days of emergency lodging assistance.
- For emergency situations unrelated to domestic violence circumstances.



DISASTER RELIEF

- Fire
- Flood
- Snow
- Natural Disaster



MEDICAL NEEDS

- Vision
- Hearing
- Dental Care
- Related Travel / Lodging
- Medical device or equipment



FOSTER CARE SUPPORT

Assistance supporting foster children and foster families when eligible.



DENTAL & ORTHODONTIC ASSISTANCE

UP TO
\$5,000
PER FISCAL YEAR

Eligible Tribal Members may receive assistance for dental and orthodontic services.

A referral from
Ilanka Dental Clinic
is required prior to application.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1 Contact the 477 Department.
- 2 Complete an SSRF Application.
- 3 Submit supporting documentation.
- 4 Applications are reviewed by the SSRF Committee.
- 5 Recommendations outside policy may be forwarded to Tribal Council for consideration.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- ✓ Assistance is based on demonstrated need.
- ✓ Funding availability may affect approval amounts.
- ✓ SSRF is intended for emergency and hardship situations.
- ✓ Additional documentation may be required depending on the request.
